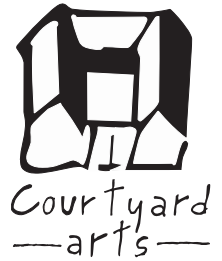


Courtyard Open Exhibition 2012

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



Up to three works per Artist may be submitted in any medium. 2D and 3D works accepted.

Size limits: 2D: 90cm x 90cm, 3D: 90cm x 50cm x 90cm. All 2D works must be framed and wired ready for hanging, except for work on canvas stretchers, where framing is optional. Clip frames and metal frames are not permitted. **Works not ready for hanging will be rejected.**

Both 2D and 3D works must have a strung label visible from the front with the following details: *Artist's name, medium, price, title, edition no.* This information must match the information on the Entry Form. Please also mark **TOP** on the back of the work.

Artists should protect their work with bubble wrap. Please cut a flap in the bubble wrap and secure with tape, to allow the work to be easily viewed.

The entry fee is **£3 per piece of work** (£2 per piece for members of Courtyard Arts) plus a handling fee of £5 per entrant. Cheques to be made payable to Courtyard Arts. Debit/credit cards and cash also accepted.

Artists are responsible for their own insurance.

Work for sale must be priced to include a 25% commission which will be taken in the event of work being sold. **Work not for sale to be clearly marked NFS.**

Submission/drop-off of artwork plus entry form is to COURTYARD ARTS, Port Vale, Hertford, SG14 3AA on Friday 30th and Saturday 31st March, between 10:00am and 4:00pm.

Collection of unselected work is from COURTYARD ARTS on Thursday 5th and Saturday 7th April between 10:00am and 4:00pm.

Collection of unsold exhibited work is from COURTYARD ARTS on Saturday 21st April between 4:00pm and 5:00pm.

All are invited to the Private View and Prize Giving at Courtyard Arts, Port Vale, Hertford, SG14 3AA on Thursday 5th April 7:00pm - 9:00pm
