



2022 ARTIST IN RESIDENCE - CONDITIONS

- A £200 honorarium will be paid to the Artist towards travel and material expenses.
- Courtyard Arts is open Tuesday to Saturday, 10am- 4pm and the Artist is expected to be present in the gallery during these hours, including at least two Saturdays. Provision may be possible for working additionally outside of these hours. Provision to make, source or research work off site during opening hours should be included in your proposal and agreed with the Gallery Manager.
- The Artist will have sole use of the Courtyard Arts gallery space to work and exhibit for the period of the residency. Work may be exhibited at anytime including, if appropriate, a more formal end of residency exhibition and/or event.
- The Artist is expected to supply his/her own materials and equipment for the residency. Additional materials and equipment may be available on request from Courtyard Arts.
- The Artist is expected to devise and deliver a two-hour workshop based on his/her practice and/or the skills employed in the residency. To take place at an appropriate and agreed time with support as required.
- Work may be made available for sale as appropriate, with all sales subject to 30% commission to Courtyard Arts.
- Any proposed material alterations to the gallery must be included in your proposal and approved in advance by the Gallery Manager. At the end of the residency the gallery must be vacated in the same condition as it was found. The Artist is responsible for any damages and breakages that occur during the residency.
- Matters concerning the Artist's work and the gallery space to be directed to the Gallery Manager.
